

Mauka aino o Konohiki. Kamaiki, aino o Kahoau.
Makai, aino o Makapepea. Kaena. Ahupuaa "Kalulu".
Ua loa ia ia hui Apana aino no Pahula mai
i ka wa o la aia o Poki maanaka ake o ka M. H. 1839, a ua
noho oleulu via a hiki i ka maanaka ake ma ka
Kaiwi. Konohiki. Ua roaio ka olelo hiki o Kawaihoa, paha
ia hui ike.

Kawaihoa, Sworn. I know his Parcel of land in the *ili* of Punanana, Kaunolu, Lanai. 1 Parcel of land.

2 *Moo uala* (sweet potato sections) & *mala ko* (sugar cane patch) & *moku mauu* (grass land/pasture section). The boundaries are thus.

Mauka, land of *Konohiki*. *Kamaiki*, land of *Kahoau*. *Makai*, land of *Makapepea*. *Kaena*, *Ahupuaa* of "Kalulu."

He received this Parcel of land from Pahula in the time that Poki was living, before the year 1839 [1829], and has resided there peacably to this time. No one has objected.

Kaiwi, Sworn. The testimony of Kawaihoa is true, my knowledge is the same.
