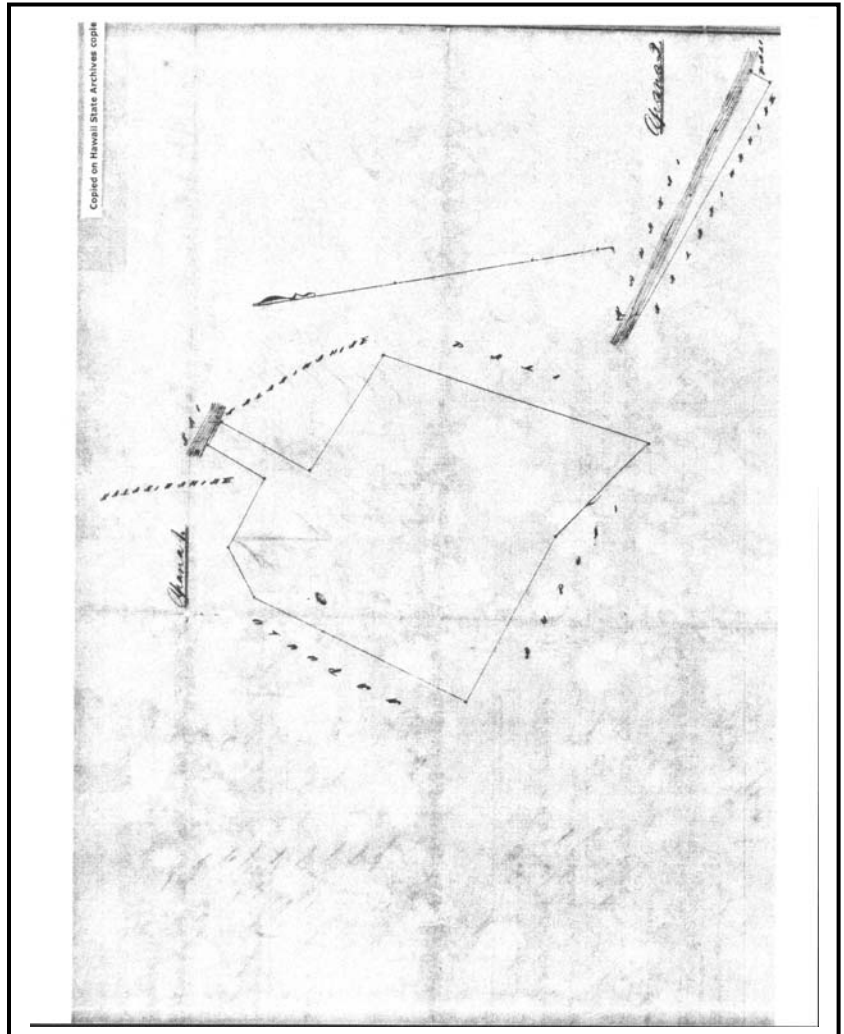


Figure 12. Notes of Survey for Royal Patent Land Grant No. 3033 to Keamo, at Kaunolu. Hawaii State Archives.

Parcel 1. Beginning at the Eastern corner of this parcel, where it meets with Pali and Kalaniwahine, and running to the:

South 28° West 1400 links along Pali;
North 36 ¼° West 662 links along Government;
North 52 ½° West 950 links along Government;
North 35 ¾° East 1082 links along Napuulu;
North 72 ¾° East 290 links along Napuulu;
South 52 ½° East 388 links along Kalaniwahine;
North 39 ¾° East 326 links along Kalaniwahine;
South 54 ½° East 133 links along Shore;
South 38 ½° West 514 links along Kalaniwahine;
South 49° East 700 links along Kalaniwahine;
to the first corner.

Containing 20. 1/10 Acres

Parcel 2. At Kaunolu.

Beginning at the Eastern corner of this parcel, where it adjoins Pali and the Beach, and running:

South 38° West 100 links along Pali;
North 52° West 1555 links along Kalaniwahine;
Then running along the beach to the first point.

Containing 0.75/100 Acre.
